LKG: Timings for issuance of admission form from 6.30 am to 12.30 pm

All the registered candidates can complete the admission process from 13/02/2018.

- Parents who have registered for Girls Section have to approach the office of Principal In – Charge in Girls Section with the child for the admission form and complete the admission formalities.
- Parents who have registered for Boys Section have to approach the office of Controller of Examination in Boys Section with the child for the admission form and complete the admission formalities.

Class XII: In the subjects studied in Class XI

The cut-off date of fresh admission for classes IX – XII will be June 25, 2018. Later to the cut-off date transfer from any CBSE School will be allowed as per the availability of seats in that particular class provided the student has already registered for CBSE in the previous school for the class they are seeking admission to.

Students will be allowed to take a particular 2nd Language in Class IX only if they have studied that as 3rd Language up to Class VIII. However, students will be allowed to take Hindi / Arabic without any restriction.

Students from other International Indian Schools of the Kingdom are admitted directly without entrance, based on the availability of the seat.

Criteria for Stream Allotment in Class XI: Based on Pre-board Marks:

- For PCM/PCB : 55% in Science & Mathematics
- For PCMB : 60% in Science & Mathematics
- For Commerce : 45% in all subjects
- For Humanities : Interested candidates (33% & above)

Documents required at the time of Admission Process:

1. Passport copy of the Father, Mother & Child
2. Iqama Copy of the Father, Mother & Child
3. NOC from the Employer of the Father
4. Original TC
5. Copy of the Final Report Cards of academic sequence starting from Class I to the last class attended for the students seeking admission in class II & above.
6. CBSE Registration details for Classes IX – XII
7. If migrating from India, the transfer certificate must be attested by the District Education Officer, Ministry of Education in India & Saudi Embassy /Consulate.
8. If migrating from other GCC countries the transfer certificate must be attested by the Ministry of Education of that country and Saudi Embassy in that country.
